The Institute of Biomembranes (IB) is an interdisciplinary research institute and graduate school at Utrecht University, accommodating 18 research groups from the faculties of Science (Departments Biology and Chemistry), Medicine, University Medical Centre, and Veterinary Medicine.

The research groups of the IB have a main interest in biomembranes and its scientific mission is focussed on the following three themes.

1. Structure, function and organization of lipids and proteins in biological membranes.
2. Biogenesis of membranes and the transport and sorting of lipids and proteins.
3. The role of biomembranes in signal transduction via membrane receptors, cell-cell-, and cell-matrix interactions
